 - Scope of Services for Kinsley Construction's Paving Contract—proposal to overlay Borough parking lot at 1.5" depth (66 tons), including Paving Fabric (approx. 100 sq. yds) & Line Painting (13 spaces incl. handicapped space)—Total cost--\$9,600 (\$6,600 pavement, \$1,800 paving fabric, \$1,200 line painting)—**Council accepted Kinsley Construction's proposal for \$9,600 at their October 4th, 2021 Meeting.**
