## Spring cleaning?

York County Solid Waste Authority is holding a free residential household hazardous waste collection on Saturday, May 1st from 9am to 1pm at their Ash Recycling & Processing Facility located at 2650 Blackbridge Road, York.

Household hazardous products include corrosive, flammable, reactive or toxic chemicals, such as drain cleaners, gasoline, chemistry kits or pesticides.

All participants must remain in their vehicles, wear a mask, and prior to admittance, have all hazardous products in the trunk or bed of the vehicle, **NOT** the back seat.

Anyone not able to participate on May 1st, may dispose of their HHW items in their regular garbage, **NOT** with recycling. If you have an item that Penn Waste will not pick up curbside, you can deliver it to York County Resource Recovery Center, but a disposal fee may apply. ## Want to help keep sewer rates low?

PLEASE do **NOT** flush wipes which claim to be "flushable"!! Manufacturers may claim the wipes are flushable, but just because they go down the toilet does **NOT** mean they decompose.

Fabrics & fibers from such items wreak havoc on a sewer system, causing pumps & equipment to clog which results in **thousands** of dollars in repairs!

**If you use flushable wipes, PLEASE just throw them away with regular trash! Thank you!**



As of January 1st, 2021, the York County Treasurer's office has taken over the collection of real estate & school taxes for Stewartstown Borough. Residents' tax bills will include a return, addressed envelope to mail the payment to York County Treasurer, PO Box 2848, York, PA 17405

If you prefer to pay your bill in person, the following **two days only** are scheduled for in-person collection at the Borough Office.

- Thursday, April 1st from 3:00pm-4:30pm
- Tuesday, April 13th from 3:00pm-4:30pm

Other payment options will be listed on the tax bills mailed to residents. **Please do not drop off tax payments at the Borough Office.** Thank you.

**Some important Ordinances to remember** (these can be read in their entirety on our website)

- **2004-08—Open Burning**—May is Open Burning month in the Borough. Anyone requesting to open burn must call Asst. Fire Chief Ira Walker, Jr. at (717)324-6521 before doing so. Outdoor cooking and/or entertainment fires are permitted all year.
- **2010-04—Nuisance Ordinance, Section 6—Pets as a Nuisance—**
  - Dogs running at large in town are prohibited. The Borough has an Animal Control Officer who can pick up loose or unattended dogs not wearing a current dog license, current rabies tag and/or owner identification tag.
  - With permission from a property owner, the Animal Control Officer may place cruelty-free traps on private property for stray cats, which will then be taken to the SPCA.
  - Animal defecation is prohibited on public and private property. **Please clean up after your pets when walking around town or at Hopewell Area Fairgrounds, ball fields & park.**
- **2010-04—Nuisance Ordinance, Section 4—Vegetative Growth—**
  - Weeds & grass that exceeds 6" in height is prohibited.
  - Tree limbs, branches, bushes or flowers should not hang over the sidewalk or street right-of-way **unless** there is a 7' clearance on the travel surface.
  - Trees, hedges, bushes, flowers, fencing or other vegetation should not impede the clear sight triangle, 75' in all directions.

**Code RED...** Stewartstown Borough provides critical notifications to its residents through CodeRED. By signing up, you will be contacted in the event of water main breaks, boil water notices, etc., that affect your area. **Stewartstown Senior Center — 26 S. Main Street**

The Senior Center provides meals every Wednesday to residents 60 years of age or older. You get a hot meal for Wednesday, and a frozen meal (TV dinner) for Thursday and one for Friday. With every hot meal you get a slice of bread or roll and a dessert. With every frozen meal you get a slice of bread, a half-pint carton of milk, a 4 oz. container of juice and a cookie. They ask for a donation of \$1.00 per meal. The meals are made and delivered to the Senior Center by The Nutrition Group.
