In case you missed the letter......Stewartstown Sewer & Water Authority will put the following rate increase into effect January 1st, 2022.

Water Rates as of January 1, 2022

Flat rate--\$25.00 (0-3,000 gallons) \$7.00/1,000 gals(4,000-5,000 gals) \$7.50/1,000 gals (6,000-9,000 gals)

\$8.00/1,000 gals(10,000 gals & up)

Sewer Rates as of January 1, 2022

Flat rate—\$105.00 (NO increase) \$2.50/1,000 gals(4,000-5,000 gals) \$3.50/1,000 gals (6,000-9,000 gals) \$4.00/1,000 gals (10,000 gals & up)

**Please note, this is the first rate increase since 2007!

A reminder that Penn Waste cannot accept electronics with regular trash.



Winter is coming!! Please be aware of these important Ordinances to keep our town safe! All of these Ordinances may be read in their entirety on our website, www.stewartstown.org

· 2005-05—Snow Emergency Plan Ordinance

Phase 1 of the Borough's Snow Emergency Plan prohibits parking on all Borough streets including State roads once the Snow Emergency is in effect. Police, fire, ambulance & other emergency vehicles are exempt from this restriction. The Ordinance allows for any parked or abandoned vehicle in violation to be towed to an area selected by the Borough. All towing & storage charges will be the responsibility of the vehicle owner.

Phase 2 of the Snow Emergency Plan prohibits parking on all Borough streets including State roads, as stated above but also prohibits motor vehicles to travel on such streets & roads, excluding all emergency vehicles.

2004-02—Snow Removal Ordinance

This Ordinance requires snow & ice to be removed within 24 hours after the cessation of snow, sleet or freezing rain.

- Mommy & Me Play Dates- For ages 2-5 years of age, every Tuesday from January 25th -April 5th from 10am-12pm at the HARP Gymnasium.  - **Wednesday** session from 10:00am to 10:40am at the HARP indoor gymnasium. Dates: February 2, 9, 16, 23 and March 2. Fee: \$60 HARP Resident & \$65 Non-HARP Resident. Fee includes a mini basketball the child will use each week and then take home to continue working on their skills once they have completed the program.
- Afterschool Dodgeball Program- We will play different versions of dodgeball each week. Program will be held Wednesday afternoons in February 2022 and will be for ages 6-8 from 4pm-5pm and ages 9-12 from 5pm-6pm at the HARP Gymnasium. Registration fee for all 4 sessions is \$30 per child and offers a \$5 sibling discount. Drop in fee of \$10 per session for those that are not pre-registered.
