Yard Sale Ordinance 2004-01

An Ordinance of the Borough Council to require permits for yard sales and regulate the number of yard sales per year.



Section 1- Definitions:

- Yard Sale
 – shall mean any public sale of goods on residential property including but not limited to, the residential garage, home, lawn, or yard.
- Permit

 shall refer to the form that must be obtained, completed, and submitted along with the respective fees.

Section 4– Frequency and Duration Limitations:

- Borough residents are permitted to have two (2) yard sales per household in a calendar year.
- The maximum duration of a yard sale is two (2) consecutive days.
- The approved yard sale must be held within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of the yard sale permit.

Section 5- Fee Schedule:

- The fee for the first permit issued to a household during the calendar year shall be ten (\$10.00) dollars.
- The fee for the second permit issued to a household during the same calendar year as the first permit is twenty-five (\$25.00)

Ordinance 2003-06

An Ordinance of the Borough prohibiting juveniles 17 years of age and under to be on, remain in, or upon any street, highway, alley, park, playground, sidewalk, private parking lot open to the public, or other public place in the Borough between the hours of 11:00 pm and 5:00 am, unless accompanied by a parent, guardian, or any person having legal custody of said juvenile. It shall be unlawful for juveniles to be upon said areas if going to or returning from their place of legal employment and in which event, such juvenile shall present proof of said employment to any law enforcement officer.

Ordinance 2003-02

An Ordinance of the Borough prohibiting the use of skate-boards on public sidewalks, commercial businesses, and other designated areas.

Restrictions—It shall be unlawful for any person to use or ride, propel or otherwise operate skateboards, roller blades, scooters, roller skates or other similar riding equipment on sidewalks designated.

Designated streets and/or sidewalks:

- All sidewalks adjacent to PA State route 24 (also known as North & South Main Street) for its entire length.
- B) All sidewalks adjacent to PA State Route 851 along Hill Street, W. Pennsylvania Ave., and College Ave.
- C) All sidewalks along Ballast Lane.

Baby wipes, floor-cleaning wipes, other disposable wipes, even "flushable" wipes and feminine hygiene items all can cause major headaches and costs in a sewer system. These products can particularly cause pumps to clog and sewage to back-up. The costs of clogging pumps or even upgrading of pumps are ultimately a sewage customer cost. In addition to wipes and "flushable" wipes, customers are again requested to not dispose of fats, oils and grease down household drains and plumbing. These materials should be collected and disposed of with regular trash.
